Research Analysis

SB 1922 allows the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission and the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle, Dismantler, and Manufactured Housing Commission to authorize temporary license plate vendors to provide pre-printed temporary license plates to licensed motor vehicle dealers. The vendor must provide a method for dealers to electronically enter required purchaser information for each vehicle purchase, and electronically submit such required purchaser information to Service Oklahoma every 24 hours.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1922 allows the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission and the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle, Dismantler, and Manufactured Housing Commission to issue dealer license plate to authorized temporary license plate vendors. It would require these Commissions to develop procedures for these vendors to electronically submit purchaser information to Service Oklahoma every twenty-four (24) hours. Per Service Oklahoma, the administrative costs associated with system updates and data transmission and storage of vehicle ownership information is estimated to be Ninety Thousand dollars (\$90,000.00) to the agency.
