## **Research Analysis**

SB 1930 provides that the deployment, implementation, or use of a motor carrier safety improvement by or as required by a motor carrier or its related entity, including by contract, shall not be considered when evaluating an individual's status as an employee or independent contractor, or as a jointly employed employee. The measure defines "motor carrier safety improvement".
