Research Analysis

Engrossed Senate Bill 1943 requires annual registration with the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control for individuals involved in various activities related to controlled dangerous substances. Registrants are obligated to disclose all beneficial owners of their entity. The measure removes the provision imposing double registration fees for late renewals by medical facility registrants exceeding 30 days and eliminates the \$10.00 fee for duplicate registration certificates. Additionally, it grants authority to the Director to establish rules concerning registration application periods.
