The amendment to SB 200 clarifies that the Corporation Commission and the Department of Environmental Quality have the ability to adopt, modify, repeal and enforce permanent or emergency rules pertaining to the Underground Injection Control Program.

The amendment further clarifies that any fees imposed by either agency should be to cover the cost of the Program.

Fiscal Analysis
