## **Research Analysis**

SB 2008 directs certain entities that receive funding through the Rural Economic Action Plan to develop a plan for measuring the qualitative effects of projects. The plan may involve surveys or inquiries of the public, local governments, or municipalities. These entities must submit a report to the Department of Commerce by January 1, 2027, detailing the effects of at least two funded projects. Expenditures for creating the plan and report must be covered using initial planning expenditure payments.
