**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 290 increases the pay for a poll inspector from \$110 to \$225 and increases the pay for a poll judge or clerk from \$100 to \$200. Per the State Election Board (SEB), the total cost to implement this measure would be \$1,610,00. It is expected that the SEB would request additional appropriations to cover the anticipated cost of this measure.

The CCR to SB 290 restores the title and removes the emergency; therefore, there is no change in the fiscal impact analysis from the previous engrossed version of the measure.

**Other Considerations**
