**Research Analysis**

SB 299 extends the Oklahoma Advisory Council on Indian Education until 2026. The measure modifies the appointing authority for membership by allowing the Speaker of the House of Representatives to appoint 5 members, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate to appoint 4 members. The measure provides that a vacancy on the Council in a seat representing an Indian tribe or the tribal education department of an Indian tribe may be filled by the original appointing authority from a list of nominations submitted by the elected executive leaders of Indian tribes in the state. Appointments to fill any vacancy on the Council shall be made within three months following the vacancy.
