Impact:	Highway and Bridge Designations Honoring Certain Individuals Killed In Performance of Duties: \$1,300

Research Analysis

The amendment to the engrossed version of SB 300 adds a highway memorial in Creek County to be designated as LCpl Nelson Matlock Memorial Highway.

Fiscal Analysis

The amendment to SB 300 adds a highway designation on State Highway 66 in Creek County for LCpl Nelson Matlock. Title 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the United States Armed Forces, Oklahoma Highway Patrol, peace officers, and first responders who were killed in the performance of their duties.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) currently estimates a cost of \$1,300 per location that meets these qualifications, with one sign needed at each end of the designated highway or bridge.
