**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB 322 allows Oklahoma tuition aid grants to be used for comprehensive transition and postsecondary programs approved by the United States Department of Education.

Further, the measure creates the Oklahoma's Promise Opportunity Scholarship Act which will provide scholarships to students attending postsecondary programs for students with intellectual disabilities. The scholarship amount will cover the student's tuition to program. The measure details financial and academic eligibility. The State Regents are authorized to administer the scholarship program.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Oklahoma's Promise scholarship program is funded through "off the top" money which is approved by the State Board of Equalization and is not appropriated by the Legislature. As such, it would not have a direct impact on the appropriations process. However, it may reduce the amount that is available for the Legislature to appropriate. It is not known how many may be eligible, apply, and fulfill the requirements of the program, but it is not anticipated to result in a significant negative fiscal impact.
