Research Analysis

The committee substitute to SB 325 modifies the timeframe as it relates to commencement of trial after the initial appearance by the person if the person is being held in jail. The measure requires that a person must be brought to trial within 9 months. The measure modifies the reasons why a continuance may be granted. The measure also requires that if a court determines after a hearing that the right to a speedy trial has not been violated, the court is to set the case for review within 3 months.
