**Research Analysis**

SB 325 modifies the timeframe as it relates to commencement of trial after a person is charged with a crime and held in jail. The measure requires that a person must be brought to trial within 9 months. The measure modifies the reasons why a continuance may be granted and limits the number of continuances that may be granted under certain conditions.
