**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 352 modifies provisions regarding the use of air bows while hunting. The measure allows a permanently physically disabled person to use an air bow as a legal hunting method during any open season. The measure limits a person using an airbow during archery season to antlerless deer only. Lastly, anyone can use an airbow to hunt nuisance wildlife and feral swine.
