Research Analysis

The floor substitute to engrossed Senate Bill 423 provides that any person 15, 16, or 17 years of age who is charged with eluding a peace officer will be in violation of certain provisions of [21 O.S. § 540A](#) and be held accountable as a youthful offender.

CHANGES BETWEEN FLOOR SUBSTITUTE AND ENGROSSED VERSION

The engrossed version was a measure relating to the costs expended by adoptive families. The floor substitute removes all previous language and replaces it with the language summarized above.

Fiscal Analysis

The Floor Amendment to SB423 modifies certain acts that shall cause certain persons to be held accountable as youthful offenders. The measure does not mandate any appropriation or expenditure relating to a state agency, but rather clarifies certain criminal culpability standards. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
