Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB 428 requires every school district to use a school security alert and response system. The State Board of Education is required to adopt a list of approved systems for school districts to choose from. At a minimum, the systems must:

- Automatically alert designated school personnel when an emergency response is initiated;
- Provide emergency responders with floor plans and other relevant information; and
- Integrate designated school personnel with emergency responders in order to provide real-time situational updates.
