The engrossed version of SB 556 finds any notarial officer who fails to make a good faith effort to identify the person signing the document guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of up to \$1,000, 10 days of imprisonment, or both.

In its current form, SB556 proposes that any notarial officer who fails to make a good faith effort to identify the person appearing before the notary be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine and imprisonment.
