Engrossed SB600 require applicants for sales tax permits to be at least 18 years old unless a guardian applies for the permit on behalf of the minor.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, SB 600 proposes to require an individual or sole proprietor to be at least 18 years of age to obtain a sales tax permit. SB 600 also requires promoters or organizers to provide certain information to special event vendors for reporting sales tax collections and other information. The measure also removes the deduction allowed to compensate the promoter or organizer of a special event.

Officials from the Oklahoma Tax Commission anticipate a minimal increase in sales tax revenue beginning in fiscal year 2024 as a result of the proposal.
