Fiscal Analysis

SB 682 removes the requirement that individuals who are issued a non-domiciled commercial learner permit or a non-domiciled commercial driver license to have an H2A Temporary Agricultural worker permit or be a participant in the J-1 Exchange Visitor Program. While data on the number of non-domiciled workers who will likely apply for these licenses is not available at this time, Service Oklahoma has determined that this measure would have a minimal impact to driver license collections, with an anticipated increase in revenue generated by the agency not to exceed \$10,000.
