The engrossed version of SB 811 grants the ABLE Commission the discretion over whether the holder of a retail license will be subject to license revocation or administrative fines if it determines that the holder sold alcohol to a person under the age of 21.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure grants the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission the authority to levy fines in certain situations when an alcoholic beverage licensee has sold alcohol to a person under the age of 21. In its current form, SB811 has the potential to increase the amount of fines collected by the state, but this is a new type of fine and its frequency is not predictable. Therefore, there is no anticipated negative impact to state budget or appropriations.
