## **Fiscal Analysis**

This measure grants the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission the authority to levy fines in certain situations when an alcoholic beverage licensee has sold alcohol to a person under the age of 21. In its current form, SB811 has the potential to increase the amount of fines collected by the state, but this is a new type of fine and its frequency is not predictable. Therefore, there is no anticipated negative impact to state budget or appropriations.
