SB 835 authorizes the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority to lease a space identified by the Director of the Department of Human Services or the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to a third party to be used as a child care center for state employees.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 835 authorizes the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority to lease space that has been identified as an appropriate location for third parties to provide services relating to child care centers. Since this measure only grants an authorization, there would be no fiscal or revenue considerations for the state at this time; however, if lease agreements were to be made with third party entities, there would be potential revenue generated from those agreements.
