## **Research Analysis**

The amendment to the floor substitute for SB 849 specifies that the Oklahoma Broadband Office must update their statewide broadband services map periodically through submission by the private providers and removes the requirement for such updates to come at request of the Office.

SB 849, as amended, modifies certain reporting procedures for private and satellite-based broadband service providers that have been designated as eligible telecommunications carriers pursuant to 47 U.S.C., Section 214(e)(6). Such providers must give the Oklahoma Broadband Office a copy of the data they submit to the FCC. Map data must also be updated periodically rather than annually. All information submitted under this measure must remain confidential and cannot be publicly disclosed without the provider's consent.
