**Research Analysis**

The first floor substitute to SB 875 prohibits any state agency, political subdivision, or elected or appointed official to use state funds, personnel, or facilities to implement the provisions of any treaty that has not been approved by two-thirds vote of the United States Senate. The provisions of this measure are to be applied to any treaty drafted under the framework of a WHO Convention, Agreement, or Other International Agreement on Pandemic Prevention, Preparedness, and Response or for amendments of the International Health Regulation. Violations could result in an injunction and the payment of damages up to \$10,000 per violation plus attorney fees.
