## **Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 927 authorizes the Oklahoma Real Estate Commission to issue cease and desist orders and contract with debt collection attorneys or debt collection entities. The measure also clarifies certain provisions of law relating to unlicensed entities conducting sales, leases, and purchases of real estate for their own use.

The Commission make take action against a licensee for placing any contract, assignment, affidavit, or other writing that restricts real property to collect commission or coerce payment on public county records. Additional causes for action are dangerous incompetence, failure to respond to Commission notices, and deceptive practices.

The measure also authorizes the Commission to spend excess funds in the Oklahoma Real Estate Education and Recovery Fund to promote the advancement of real estate education, implement and maintain a public registry, produce and distribute a newsletter, and provide education grants to higher learning institutions.
