**Research Analysis**

SB 930 establishes the Aero Student Pathways for Aerospace Careers and Education (AeroSPACE) program. The program is to address the workforce needs of the aviation and aerospace industry by implementing a common aerospace educational curriculum initiative statewide. The program is also tasked with partnering with primary and secondary schools, career technology centers, and higher education providers to promote and organize curriculum, enhanced classroom instruction, and research based educational programs.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 930 establishes the "AeroSPACE Program," an education partnership between the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission (OAC) and primary, secondary, career technology, and higher education providers. Per the OAC, this measure simply updates language and codifies the current education practice already in place, therefore this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
