Bill Analysis

HB 2056 requires ballots for each election day precinct to be printed in advance of election day. The measure authorizes the Secretary of the State Election Board to order the printing of more ballots in the event of a ballot shortage or due to an emergency or unforeseen circumstance. Additionally, the measure requires any registered voter that wishes to vote to appear at the polling place for his or her assigned precinct. The measure prohibits the Board as well as any county election board from utilizing vote centers for voting on election day. Such centers may be used as authorized by the Board in the event of an emergency.
