Bill Analysis

HB 2210 0 provides that if a minor is convicted as an adult for an offense that the minor committed when he or she was under 18 years of age and the court finds by clear and convincing evidence that the person against whom the minor was convicted of committing the offense trafficked the minor or sexually abused or sexually assaulted the minor within 90 days before the commission of the offense, the court may depart from the mandatory minimum sentence or sentence enhancement, any portion of a sentence, or transfer the minor to the jurisdiction of the juvenile division of the district court.
