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Bill Analysis

HB 2998 creates the Laser Hair Removal Act. The measure requires each laser practitioner to use lasers or pulsed light devices only if such devices are approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Such persons must also obtain licensure from the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. Each facility must be overseen by a physician. Advanced Practice Registered Nurses shall be exempt from this oversight requirement. The measure authorizes the use of laser hair removal without a referral.

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
