Bill Analysis

HB 3158 directs the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering to issue a license to any nonprofit 501(c)(3) tax-exempt school located within a correctional facility that proposes to provide cosmetology or barbering training courses in such a facility. Any organization intending to operate such a school shall submit an application to the Board containing the information outlined in the measure. Applicants must also obtain a memorandum of understanding from the Department of Corrections showing that the Department shall authorize the use of its space for 1 year to operate the school. Such school shall not charge tuition. The Board shall permit an applicant's inmate identification badge as his or her identification for purposes of enrollment.
