Bill Analysis

HB 3457 modifies the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program to provide eligibility for students who are children of a full-time certified classroom teacher who has been employed by a public school district for a minimum of 10 years. The bill states that there will be no financial qualification for children of teachers; however, the State Regents for Higher Education will be required to verify the full-time employment status of the student's parent prior to issuing any benefit award.
