Bill Analysis

HB 3807 provides that a participating member of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System may make an irrevocable written election to include newly-hired law enforcement support staff in the System. The member must notify the System 7 days prior to including such staff. Support staff included in the System in such a manner shall participate in and make contributions to the System as other participating members of the System. The measure also expands the System to include newly-hired game wardens of the Department of Wildlife Conservation who are certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training if the Department has made an irrevocable election to become a participating employer. The measure defines such an expansion of the System as a nonfiscal retirement bill as it relates to the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act.
