## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1055 strikes all language authorizing public bodies to conduct executive session using videoconference technology. The Oklahoma Tax Commission may still conduct executive sessions using videoconference technology with a taxpayer to discuss confidential taxpayer matters. The CS allows the board of a community action agency to maintain quorum for the entire duration of the meeting whether using an in-person site, videoconference sites or any combination of such sites to achieve a quorum. The measure deletes expired language related to authorizing public bodies to conduct executive session using videoconference technology during an emergency declaration.
