**Bill Analysis**

SB 1059 prohibits any candidate committee from contributing to any other candidate for state or federal office. The measure also specifies that unlimited committees are subject to the \$5,000.00 limit as it relates to such committees contribution to other committees. Limited committees as well as partnerships, limited liability companies, corporations, and labor unions are prohibited from contributing to unlimited committees organized exclusively for the purpose of making independent expenditures or electioneering communications. The measure requires every political party committee or political action committee making independent expenditures to be formed and domiciled in this state. The treasurer and compliance officer of such committees shall be residents of this state with a valid street address and telephone number where such officers may be reached during working hours. Additionally, the measure prohibits any officer of an unlimited committee from receiving compensation from a candidate or candidate committee.
