Bill Analysis

SB 1061 provides that any person convicted of a second offense for possession of a Schedule III, IV, or V within a 10-year period following the completion of the execution of a sentence or deferred judgment for such possession shall be guilty of a felony. Such persons shall be subject to a term of imprisonment for not less than 1 year and not more than 5 years as well as a fine maximum fine of \$5,000.00. Such persons shall also participate in an assessment and may be required to complete a diversion program approved by the court. Persons convicted of a first offense may also be required to complete a diversion program approved by the court. The measure removes marijuana from the list of substances listed in current law as it relates to sentencing for possession.
