Bill Analysis

SB 1114 requires the State Election Board to update the system used for ballots for elections in order to allow all ballots to have a unique identifier number or code printed in at least 2 locations on the ballot as well as have a perforated section that includes the unique identifier number or code where the voter can tear off that portion of the ballot to keep as a method to identify his or her ballot. The measure requires all ballots to be digitized and be made available to the public through a database within 30 days. The database shall be searchable by id number and shall be maintained and searchable on the publicly accessible website for at least 2 years after the election.
