**Bill Analysis**

SB 1189 appropriates \$18,460,000.00 from the Statewide Recovery Fund to the State Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for the purpose of funding increased costs for the expansion of the Tulsa Center for Behavioral Health. The measure creates the Statewide Recovery Special Account for the appropriation. The Department is authorized to retain no more than 2% of the funds appropriated to reimburse costs incurred by the Department or on behalf of the Department. The Department is required to submit a quarterly report to the respective Chairs of Appropriation in the Senate and House and to appear before such committees no later than 6 months after the effective date upon request.
