**Bill Analysis**

SB 1190 appropriates \$2,215,000.00 from the Statewide Recovery Fund to the Military Department for the construction of a holistic health and fitness center for service members and first responders, \$1,190,000.00 to address educational disparities through various services, and \$800,000.00 to provide effective service delivery in coordination of response assets to emergencies. The measure creates the Statewide Recovery Special Account for each appropriation made in the measure. The Department is authorized to retain no more than 2% of the funds appropriated to reimburse costs incurred by the Department or on behalf of the Department. The Department is required to submit a quarterly report to the respective Chairs of Appropriation in the Senate and House and to appear before such committees no later than 6 months after the effective date upon request.
