Bill Analysis

SB 1279 directs the Department of Public Safety to establish and administer a pilot program to increase the availability of Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) training. The program shall prepare police officers and other qualified persons to conduct various drug-impairment detection tests at the roadside. Additionally, the measure appropriates \$500,000.00 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department to establish the program.
