Bill Analysis

SB 129 creates the Millstone Act of 2023. The measure prohibits any physician from providing gender transition procedures or referral services relating to gender transition procedures to any individual under 26 years of age. The measure exempts procedures relating to the treatment of a medically verifiable disorder of sex development, treatment of any infection or disorder that has been caused by or exacerbated by the performance of gender transition procedures, or to prevent imminent danger of death or impairment of major bodily function. Public funds may not be directly or indirectly used, granted, paid, or distributed to any entity, organization, or individual that provides gender transition procedures individuals younger than 26. Individuals found to have violated the provisions of this measure shall be guilty of felony and subject to license revocation as well as civil liability. The measure authorizes the Attorney General to bring an action to enforce compliance.
