**Bill Analysis**

SB 1363 creates the Thrive Act. It states that school districts with an identified student percentage of 40 percent or higher that opt in to the community eligibility provision of the National School Lunch Program are eligible for a certain per meal reimbursement based on the school district's enrollment. The bill requires the State Department of Education, in collaboration with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry and an institution of higher education, by July 1, 2025, and every three years thereafter to evaluate the impact of the measure and electronically submit the evaluation to the, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and the Governor.
