**Bill Analysis**

SB 1369 authorizes rural water districts, nonprofit water corporations, and all municipally owned utilities serving municipalities with a population of 10,000-50,000 to pay 50% of the costs and expenses for the removal and relocation of municipally owned utilities constructed or in place in the public right-of-way when such removal is needed to improve or reconstruct any road or highway which is part of the state highway system. The public authority with jurisdiction over the particular road or highway shall pay the remaining 50% of expenses.

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
