Bill Analysis

SB 1376 directs the Office of Juvenile Affairs to develop a pay-for-performance rate plan for Youth Services Agencies and other contractors. The measure directs the Office to reserve a portion of funds paid to contracted providers for services, which shall be matched with funds provided by the Office at a rate determined by the Board of Juvenile Affairs. Such payments may be earned quarterly by contractors using metrics established by the Board. The measure directs the Office to submit an annual report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor on December 31 of each year.
