**Bill Analysis**

SB 1419 directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to establish a program under which a family member of a Medicaid enrollee may be recognized as a family caregiver under the direction and supervision of a Registered Nurse. The program shall be established 1 year after the effective date of the measure. Such a family caregiver shall be authorized to provide services to the enrollee through a licensed home care agency. Each caregiver shall be required to fulfill certain requirements or meet certain qualifications as prescribed by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board. The Authority shall also establish reimbursement rates for such caregivers.

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
