**Bill Analysis**

SB 1453 expands approved purposes as it relates to the Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants Act to include any approved uses as authorized by opioid-related settlement agreements made by the state. The measure also broadens political subdivisions to include institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education system. The measure strikes reference to interest accrued to the Purdue Political Subdivision Fund from the Revive Oklahoma Health Foundation. The measure authorizes the Attorney General to withhold not more than 5% of the funds received by the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Revolving Fund for staff and administrative support. Alternatively, the funds withheld may be used for research.
