**Bill Analysis**

SB 1529 modifies language regarding the length of the school year. It allows a public school to offer instruction for 1,080 hours with a minimum of 150 days. The measure removes language requiring a school that seeks to offer instruction for 1,080 hours with no minimum number of days to meet certain minimum guidelines for student performance and school district cost savings.
