SB 1553 states the Legislature's intent to promote the development of renewable energy resources as well as efficiencies in generation, storage, transmission, and utilization of electric energy. The measure defines renewable energy to include energy produced from wind, solar, hydrogen, hydroelectric power, nuclear, geothermal energy, and biofuels.
