Bill Analysis

SB 1593 modifies the conditions for disqualifying a person from serving as an executor at the time a will is entered into probate. The measure provides that a person is disqualified if he or she is convicted of a crime that causes the court to determine that the person should not be entrusted with the fiduciary duties of an executor. Current law disqualifies states a person must be convicted of an “infamous” crime to be disqualified.
