**Bill Analysis**

SB 1606 creates the Oklahoma Posted Land Act. The measure authorizes the owner or lessee of any forest land or land other than forest land to post the land by either placing signs at conspicuous points and at each point of entry or by placing identifying paint marks on trees or posts around the area to be posted. The type and color of the paint to be used for posting shall be prescribed by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. Any person found post on land that is not theirs shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a maximum fine of \$250.00.
