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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1629 requires any retail electric supplier that intends to provide retail electric service to a new electric-consuming facility within a certified territory of another retail electric service to notify the incumbent provider and the Public Utility Division (PUD) of the Corporation Commission at least 15 business days prior to entrance into a contract for service between the non-incumbent retail electric service provider and the new electric-consuming facility. Information in the notice may be kept confidential upon request by the new electric-consuming facility. The notice shall include a description of the anticipated location of the new facility by GPS coordinates, a description of the size of the connected load for initial full operation to be added, and identification of the tariff under which the retail electric service provider intends to serve the facility.

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
