**Bill Analysis**

SB 1636 directs the Department of Wildlife Conservation to produce an elk population study to present to the Legislature and Governor on or before the effective date. The study shall focus on the elk population in southeastern Oklahoma and may incorporate other sources into an analysis of Oklahoma's elk population. The measure authorizes the Department to enter into agreements with other agencies to complete the study.
