**Bill Analysis**

SB 1641 authorizes any individual aggrieved by a decision of the Department of Human Services relating to placement on the Restricted Registry to appeal to the district court of the county in which the child care facility is maintained. If an individual successfully appeals the placement, the Department shall remove the individual from the Registry. Additionally, the court is directed to award appropriate relief to the prevailing individual. The measure authorizes aggrieved individuals to bring actions against the Department alleging violations of state law pertaining to the process of recording an individual on the Restricted Registry.
